INSTRUCTION FOR PROPER USE

The GLYCINE Airman watch has a screw-down crown which you have to unscrew for time-setting and corrections of calendar and 24-hour-hand.

CROWN POSITIONS:

pos. 1 Completely screwed tight: no correction possible

pos. 2 Crown unscrewed and slightly pulled to reach intermediate "correction" position (click):

a. by turning left (counter-clock-wise), you select calendar day of month;
b. by turning right (clock-wise), you move red 24-hour-hand to the desired 24-hour mark on the dial.

pos. 3 Crown unscrewed and pulled out completely: normal time setting of hour and minute hand.

SETTING OF TIME ZONES:

Local time: hour and minute hand on normal 12-hour markings

2nd time zone: Operate crown as stated in par. 2b. (above) and place red 24-hours-hand on desired hour of 24-hour-markings on dial.

Example:

European time: 16.00 h (4 pm)

Hongkong time: (+ 7 h) 23.00 h

red 24-hour-hand on figure 23 on dial; this hand will continue to mark Hongkong time.

3rd time zone: Release the steel bezel by turning the lower crown (opposite figure 8 of dial) backwards.

Now turn the ratchet steel bezel (48 positions) until desired time marking on bezel is opposite to your 24-hour hand

Example:

European time: 16.00 h (4 pm) on hands
Hongkong time: (+ 7 h) 23.00 h on 24-hour-hand

Rio de Janeiro time: (- 4 h) 12.00 h on bezel

As long as you do not change position of 24-hour-hand, you can read Rio de Janeiro time on steel topring.

In order to secure waterproof quality, it is essential to screw the crowns tight after every correction (press crown slightly against the case).
