INSTRUCTION FOR PROPER USE

The GLYCINE Airman Base 22 has a screw down crown which you have to unscrew for time-setting and corrections of calendar and 24-hour-hand.

SETTING OF TIME ZONES:

1. adjust the 12hour hand, minute and calendar day of home time.

2. adjust the 24hour hand on GMT position on the dial: you can reset the revolving 24hour bezel* when flying into a different time zone.

* Release the steel bezel by turning the lower crown (opposite figure 8 of dial) backwards. Now turn steel bezel until desired time marking on bezel is opposite to your 24-hour-hand.

3. adjust the 24hour hand to your present position. You can adjust it by the crown function (pos. 2b.) whenever you fly to a different time zone, without stopping the movement.

In order to secure waterproof quality, it is essential that you push, or push and screw, the crown tight after every correction.

CROWN POSITIONS:

pos. 1 Completely screwed tight no correction possible

pos. 2 Crown unscrewed and slightly pulled to reach intermediate „correction“ position (click)

a. by turning left (counter-clock-wise), you select calendar day of month.
b. by turning right (clock-wise) you move the arrow headed 24hour hand with red tip. You may select time zone of your position or GMT. The adjustment of the 24hour hand will not stop the movement. Adjustment is unidirectional.

pos. 3 Crown unscrewed and pulled out completely: normal time setting of 12hour hand (blue or white with SL) and minute hand
